Hot Stuff - Wood Stoves

Wood Stove Safety



Heating with wood can be safe and economical, but unlike a modern central heating system, stoves and fireplaces require careful installation and constant vigilance. In the interest of saving lives and property, we urge you to remember that if you are planning on operating a wood or coal stove this winter, take the following precautions:

- Have your chimney cleaned regularly.
- Have your installation verified by a professional.
- Burn only dry, seasoned hardwood.
- Keep all combustible material at least three feet away.
- Dispose of ashes in a metal container with tight-fitting lid.
